

Holy Week: A Continuous Liturgy

As we come toward the end of our Lenten journey, we near the highest days in the entire Liturgical Calendar: Palm Sunday, the Triduum, and Easter. Collectively, we call this time Holy Week. Each celebration has certain character and purpose; depicting the ministry, passion, death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus.



Palm or Passion Sunday commemorate Jesus' majesty. The palms are blessed as a sign of our recognition of his kingdom. We turn our focus from the joyful procession to Jesus' suffering and death.



Holy Thursday 7:00 pm

Jesus reminds us by Washing of Feet, that we are to serve one another and continue in the corporal works of Jesus' mission. In The Institution of the Holy Eucharist we remember

how Jesus gave his body, blood, soul, and divinity to his disciples. Lastly, we transfer the Blessed Sacrament to a quiet place as a reminder of Jesus' prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane. "Watch and Pray"



Good Friday: Stations of the Cross 2:00 pm Service at 7:00 pm

We remember the ultimate sacrifice that Jesus Christ paid for our salvation.



Easter Vigil: 8:00 pm

We begin in darkness and as the light grows, the darkness is dispelled. Jesus was brought to life on this sacred night. As a congregation, we renew our baptismal

promises and we are all reborn into the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

The fact is, no one is required to attend these liturgies. They are not holy days of obligation; but they contain within them the full story. Missing them is like skipping ahead in a book and just reading the final chapter to see what happens. The mystery of our faith can be understood when we walk with Jesus on the procession into Jerusalem, to the upper room, into the Garden of Gethsemane, along his way of suffering, up to Calvary, into the tomb, and then to rise again with him on the third day.

The flowers are from Lynde Greenhouses and have always been lovely. There are some new varieties this year. Please note that flowers which are listed as "assorted", means a specific color cannot be guaranteed. Flowers listed as "mixed" means that there is more than one color in the pot. There has been some price increases from the grower, but we have kept the prices as stable as possible. The prices are usually below retail unless a store is having a promotion.

Flowers will be ready for pickup from the school cafeteria on Saturday May 19th between 2 and 5:30pm and on May 20th before and after Mass.

You may also donate funds to help with purchasing flowers and landscaping for the parish grounds. This may be done in memory of someone. Use the yellow form found on the table in the back of church.

If you donate to the parish memorial gardens and purchase flowers from the flower sale, please make out two separate checks. It helps to make the bookkeeping a little easier.
