Reflections from Father Tom

Authority is to Love and Serve

Last couple weeks, the weekend readings were focusing on the Prophets and their mission. This week's readings also invite us to focus on a similar theme explaining the prophetic authority and its divine origin. When Amos was challenged by Amaziah, the priest of Bethel, Amos told him, "I was no prophet, nor have I belonged to a company of prophets; I was a shepherd and a dresser of sycamores. The LORD took me from following the flock, and said to me, Go, prophesy to my people Israel." (Amos: 7:14-15) And we hear from the Gospel, "Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two and gave them authority over unclean spirits. (Mk: 6:7)

Living in this world of freedom, we are threatened by the authority of others over us. But such authority is not to lord over the people, but to serve and lead the people of faith or a nation. We should not forget such authorities to serve the people come from God. In the Old Testament the prophets received the authority of prophesying from God. The authority that Jesus gave to the Apostles in the New Testament was to serve the people by healing, proclaiming the good news. The authority in the biblical background should always be understood in the context of service. "You call me 'teacher' and 'master,' and rightly so, for indeed I am. If I, therefore, the master and teacher, have washed your feet, you ought to wash one another's feet. I have given you a model to follow, so that as I have done for you, you should also do." (John: 13:13-15)

On our part, as followers, we should develop steadfast trust in our leaders as they are to serve us with the authority of love that originates from God. If we wish to 'be holy and without blemish before him (Christ), as St. Paul expressed in the second reading, we should be faithful and obedient to God and to his authority, passed on through the prophets of our times. Without following God one cannot lead.

Prayer: Lord, We pray for our Church and national leaders, that they will be filled with a spirit of service and authority to love and serve your people and we ask you to give us the spirit of obedience to your will.
