


Reflections from Father Tom

Works of the Holy Spirit

St. Paul's writing to the Ephesians, as we read in today's second reading, states, "Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with which you were sealed for the day of redemption. All bitterness, fury, anger, shouting, and reviling must be removed from you, along with all malice. And be kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving one another as God has forgiven you in Christ." (Ephesians 4: 30) As long as we are human beings, we are in constant struggle with good and evil, passion and compassion, and truth and untruth. In the constant battle of our life, we need to consistently work with the Holy Spirit to be sealed for the day of redemption.

In the life of everyone, it is true what St. Paul has written two thousand years ago. There are times we have gone through bitterness, fury, anger, shouting and reviling, as St. Paul has mentioned. However, if we wish not to grieve the Holy Spirit, the power of growth in the Church (Eph: 3: 16), we should live a Christian life belonging to Christ (Eph: 1: 13) and should be sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, by our life of compassion, kindness and forgiveness.

This Holy Spirit should be part of our family life as well as in the life of our faith community. This Holy Spirit is the source of truth and joy, not of sadness. If we do not adhere to the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we end up in bitterness and anger, as St. Paul mentions. We can grow in love as a community of faith only through the Spirit that unites us by compassion, forgiveness and appreciation. Anger, complaining, or murmuring is not from truth. When Jesus explained the truth of his origin and the mystery of his presence in the Eucharist, "the Jews murmured about Jesus because he said, "I am the bread that came down from heaven," (JN: 6:41) Complaining cannot be our contribution to God and community, rather our commitment to the Holy Spirit as the source of basic Christian life should be our contribution.

Prayer: O Holy Spirit, come upon us to guide us to the truth in the midst of untruth; to understanding in the midst of misunderstanding to the joy in the midst of sorrows. Amen.
