Reflection from Father Tom

A VOICE IN THE DESERT

The gospel of this weekend says, "The word of God came to John the son of Zechariah in the desert." As I was reflecting over this passage, this question came to my mind: Why did the word of God come to John in the desert? Why not in the cities?

A Desert is a place where nothing exists except the sand. There is no house, road, water, toys, or comforts. There is nothing in the desert to distract one's mind from listening to God's word. The desert is a place of suffering and challenge. It is a symbolic way of God telling us that His word would come to us only through suffering and hard life. Comfort or convenience is not the place where one can encounter God.

If we wish to celebrate Christmas we need to empty ourselves like the desert and remove all the worldly distraction from our mind, only then can we listen to the word God.

As we hear the word of God, let us prepare the way of the Lord, not our ways. "A voice of one crying out in the desert: "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths. Every valley shall be filled and every mountain and hill shall be made low. The winding roads shall be made straight, and the rough ways made smooth, and all flesh shall see the salvation of God."(Luke 3:5-6) When our ways are made smooth we can see the salvation of God.

God, give us the wisdom to prepare the way of your Son so that we will be able to see you face to face. Amen.
