

Reflection from Father Tom

Evangelization- The Way to Prepare for Christmas

As Christmas draws near, we are busy shopping and getting the gifts wrapped, but in the Gospel Jesus invites us to imitate John the Baptist. Jesus began to speak to the crowds about John, "What did you go out to the desert to see? A reed swayed by the wind? Then what did you go out to see? Someone dressed in fine clothing? Those who wear fine clothing are in royal palaces. Then why did you go out? To see a prophet? Yes, I tell you, and more than a prophet. This is the one about whom it is written: Behold, I am sending my messenger ahead of you; he will prepare your way before you.

Sharing with others what we have is the way to prepare for Christmas because Christmas is the celebration of God's sharing His only Son with this world. It is by giving that we receive.

Speaking about Sharing, there cannot be a great sharing more than sharing the good news of Jesus to others in this time of Christmas. I hope you will be aware of our Archdiocesan synod. "The faithful of this Archdiocese have gathered together over the past three years in prayer, learning and respectful listening to one another and the Holy Spirit. Now it is time for us to join you in considering the question asked so many years ago by the disciples of John the Baptist: "What then should we do?" (Lk 3:10) The Pastoral Letter issued today, You Will Be My Witnesses, reflecting on our Synod journey as well as the mysteries that took place nearly 2,000 years ago in the Upper Room, is a first response to that question, outlining a plan for the next three years aimed at helping us to be more vibrant witnesses to all that Jesus has lovingly done for us. Our shared experience throughout these last three years has led us to the truth of Jesus' conclusion that "The harvest is abundant..." (Mt 9:37) (Extract from Archbishop Hebda's letter).

In the second reading the apostle James reminds us to be patient and firm while waiting for the Lord. Be patient, brothers and sisters, until the coming of the Lord. He further instructs us, do not complain, brothers and sisters, about one another, that you may not be judged. Behold, the Judge is standing before the gates. Take as an example of hardship and patience, brothers and sisters, the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord. Complaining about one another is not a Christian attitude. If we really want to prepare for Christmas with Joy, then we need to change our hearts. The change of our hearts makes the birth of Jesus a reality in our homes and our community.

Prayer: A burden shared becomes light. A long journey traveled with love becomes short. A Christmas shared with gifts of gratitude becomes meaningful. Wishing a joyful Advent!
