Reflection from Father Tom

Who Does the Father's Will?

The Gospel today reminds every one of us to 'walk the talk' and 'talk the walk'. It is not enough to say that we are going to do it. But we have to do it. We may be like the first son who said he would go to the vineyard to work, but never went. But the second son, who refused to go, repented for his rudeness to his father and went to work in the vineyard. God is not looking at our failures or counting our sins to punish, but looking for us to come back to His home. Even though we have failed many times, He wants us to fulfill His will at the end.

St. Paul exhorts the Philippians in the second reading, which would aptly be relevant for anyone who wants to lead others. "Do nothing out of selfishness or out of vain glory, rather, humbly regard others as more important than yourselves, each looking out not for his own interests, but also for those of others."

Serving others is a call from God. A calling is a command not a request. God has called every one of us to follow the command of leading by following His commandments. As parents, teachers, managers, or ministers let us do everything for the glory of God not for our selfishness or for our vain glory.

Prayer: Lord, give me your grace to know Your will that I could do it selflessly. Amen
